# Why is the recording time of a video file different from its Start Time at GV-Center V2's main screen?

### Question

Why is the recording time of a video file different from its Start Time at GV-Center V2's main screen?

### Answer

The recordings are named according to the Greenwich Mean Time instead of the local time (host time). By naming files in a unified time system, we can avoid confusion among video files from host devices installed in different time zones. For example, an event started at 2012/12/04 6:05:52 pm (in R.O.C), which is equivalent to 2012/12/04 10:05:52 am in Greenwich Mean Time, will be shown as "Event20121204100552009" in GV-Center V2's folder.
