How do I change the recording resolution when using GV-SDI-204 Cards?

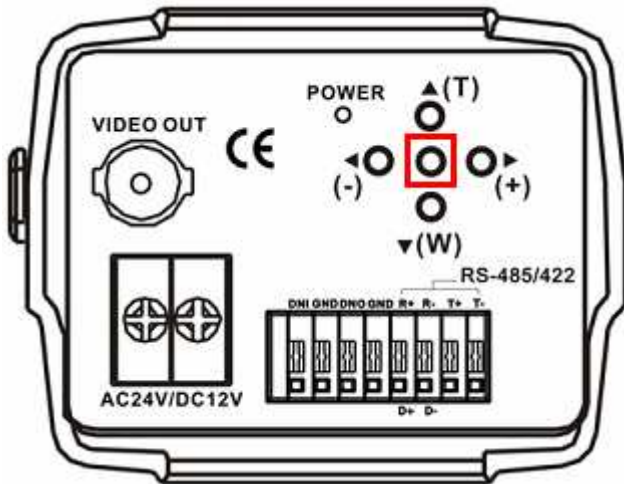
Answer

To change the recording resolution on your HD-SDI card system, you will need to change the resolution of your source HD-SDI Camera.

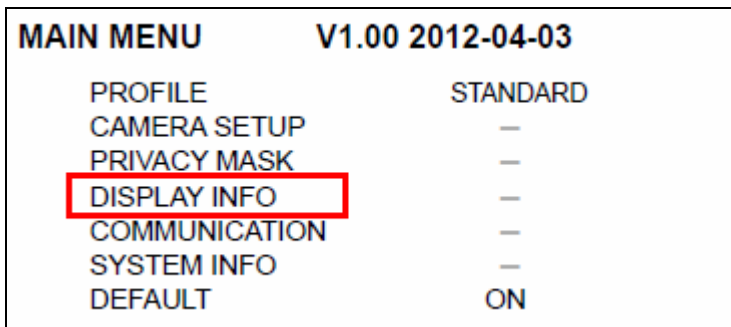
Please note that the connected HD-SDI cameras must have a resolution under 1080p_30, 720p_60 or 1080i_60. The Video Lost message will be displayed when the connected channels have higher resolution.

If you are using GV-HD-SDI Cameras, use the OSD button on the rear panel of the camera to change the resolution.

1. On the rear panel, press the **Menu** button to access the setup menu.



2. Select **Display Info**.



3. Under Display Info, select **Resolution** and select a resolution. There are 12 types of modes: 1080P60, 1080P50, 1080I60, 1080I50, 1080P30, 1080P25, 1080P59.94, 1080P29.97, 1080I59.94, 720P60, 720P50 and 720P59.94.
