# Why does the GV-IP camera's 320 x 240 image not fill up the TV monitoring screen?

### Question

Why does the GV-IP camera's 320 x 240 image not fill up the TV monitoring screen?

### Answer

When you set the resolution to 320 x 240 for the TV output, the image is smaller and does not fill up the monitoring screen. This is largely due to the specification limits of the TV output. The TV output resolution is fixed to 640 x 480. For the TV output to work properly, it is recommended to set the video resolution to 1280 x 1024 or lower. If both streams are enabled, it is recommended to set the Sub Stream to 640 x 480.
