Where can I find a player to play back files created by GV-IP Camera, GV-Compact DVR, or GV-Video Server?

### Answer

#### GV-Compact DVR V3 Series

These methods are available to play back the video files recorded at the GV-Compact DVR V3 Series:

- Play back the files recorded on the hard drive by connecting to GV-System or a computer.
- Play back the files recorded on the device over network.
- Download the files saved on the device through FTP servers.
- Play back files backed up on a DVD disc or USB storage device.

### **GV-IP Camera V2 Series**

These methods are available to play back the video files recorded at the GV-IP Camera V2 Series:

- Playback by using the memory card by connecting it directly to the GV-System through a memory card reader
- Playback by using the Remote ViewLog function over the TCP/IP network
- Playback by using the recorded files downloaded from built-in FTP Server

### **GV-Video Server (GV-VS04H, GV-VS11, GV-VS12, and GV-VS14)**

Two methods are available to play back the video files recorded at the GV-Video Server:

- Playback using the USB mass storage device by attaching it directly to the GV-System
- Playback using the Remote ViewLog function over the TCP/IP network
